## 2013 ARB GUIDELINES UPDATE

## Introduction:

The Windstorm Park Homeowner Association ("Association") is governed by the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions ("C, C & Rs") dated February 24, 1998, Document #98027957. As provided for in the C, C & Rs, the Association amended certain portions of the Architectural Rules through the adoption of the ARB Guideline Update/Clarification dated 6/23/2004 ("2004 Update").

The Architectural Review Board ("Board") adopts the following Fence Guidelines to supplement the C, C & Rs and the 2004 Update.

## I. FENCES ALONG STREET FRONTAGES:

a-A fence up to 48" in height may be erected not less than 48" from the edge of any ROW subject to the following restrictions:

- i. Fences along any street are restricted to the frontage between the back of the house and the rear property line except where a fence interferes with any setbacks including along any alleys and creeks. Where a conflict exists along an alley or at a creek, the restrictions at alleys and creeks shall apply.
- ii. A fence may run from the back of the house towards the rear of property to a point where it meets required setbacks such as an alley or creek.
- iii. No fence may be installed along any elevation of the house facing any right-of-way except along the alley which must be setback 48" from the edge of right-of-way closest to the house.

b-Any fence allowed as described in (a) above that will be taller than 48" will be setback from any right of way a distance not less than the height of the fence. As an example a 60" fence would have to be setback 60" from the sidewalk except along the alley where a fence up to 72" in height may be located at least 48" from the closest edge of the alley.

c-Any new fence built under these conditions would have to meet all other fence requirements set forth in the C, C & Rs and the 2004 Update.

d-Any fences installed prior to January 1, 2012 are approved. Any fences under dispute with the ARB at the time of this rule are not approved.
